#### Human Resource Development

CRC-Gorakhpur undertakes human resource development through running courses that include diploma level course training for Multiple Disabilities (D.Ed. Spl. Ed.- Multiple Disabilities), Autism Spectrum Disorder (D.Ed. Spl. Ed. - Autism Spectrum Disorder)& certificate course in care giving(CCCG).

#### Short Term Training Programmes & Awareness Generation Programmes

CRC- Gorakhpur conducts short term training programmes & awareness generation programmes for the purpose of spreading awareness, skill development and capacity building for various groups such as persons with disabilities, parents of persons with disabilities, rehabilitation professionals, NGOs, and other stakeholder disability related issues and emerging concepts/ paradigms in the area of disability rehabilitation.

CRC - Gorakhpur is committed to building collaborative partnerships with various groups that include PWDs, parents of PWDs& siblings of PWDs, Rehabilitation and medical Professionals, NGOs, Anganwadi, SSA and ASHA workers and other stakeholders so as to facilitate rehabilitation of PWDs and help contribute in building a more inclusive society.

#### Community-Based Rehabilitation & Outreach Programmes

To organize regular training programmes that include various groups of society so as to bring in a more inclusive approach to social rehabilitation of PWDs in society.

To identify and include PWDs and their families located in rural and remote areas of eastern Uttar Pradesh and provide supportive services as well as benefits of government schemes/ policies and programmes.

## About CRC-Gorakhpur

Composite Regional Centre for Skill Development, Rehabilitation, & Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities, Gorakhpur is functioning under the administrative control of National Institute for Empowerment of Persons with Multiple Disabilities, Chennai (Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan), Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Govt. of India). CRC-Gorakhpur as a composite regional centre became functional in 2018 and was established with the objective of providing a number of centre based clinical and community-based rehabilitation services to persons with disabilities (PWDs) in the eastern regions of Uttar Pradesh.

CRC- Gorakhpur is committed to provide rehabilitation services to all the disabilities specified in the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act 2016 which include the following conditions:

### 1. Physical disability

#### A. Locomotor disability.—

- (a) leprosy cured person
- (b) cerebral palsy
- (c) dwarfism
- (d) muscular dystrophy
- (e) acid attack victims

#### B. Visual impairment—

- (a) blindness
- (b) low-vision

#### C. Hearing impairment—

- (a) deaf
- (b) hard of hearing

#### D. Speech and language disability—

### 2. Intellectual disability

- (a) specific learning disabilities
- (b) autism spectrum disorder

### 3. Mental behaviour,

- (a) mental illness

### 4. Disability caused due to

(a) Chronic neurological conditions—

- (i) Multiple sclerosis
- (ii) Parkinson's disease



(b) Blood disorder—

- (i) haemophilia
- (ii) thalassemia
- (iii) sickle cell disease

5. Multiple Disabilities (more than one of the above specified disabilities) including deaf blindness



### Objectives

- To serve as Resource Centre for rehabilitation and special education of persons with disabilities.
- To undertake human resource development by training rehabilitation professionals, village level workers, multi-rehabilitation workers and other functionaries in Govt. and non-Govt. sector, required for providing services to persons with disabilities.
- To undertake public education programmes for creation of awareness in the parents and the community.
- To undertake designing, fabrication and fitment of aids and appliances.
- To undertake services of education and skill development leading to enhancement of opportunities for employment, rehabilitation, mobility communication recreation and integration in society.
- To undertake research and development with specific reference to needs of diverse groups of people with disability, keeping in view the nature and severity of disability in the region.
- To develop strategies for delivery of rehabilitation services suitable to the socio-cultural background of the region.
- To stimulate growth of services by encouraging and supporting voluntary organization, parents groups and self – help groups.
- To establish linkages with existing medical, educational and employment services, following the principles of community – based rehabilitation and offer extension services in the rural area.
